Dear Representative Lowey,

On behalf of the 45 undersigned organizations representing the Nursing Community Coalition, we would like to thank you for introducing the United States Nurse Corps Equity Act (H.R. 1168). The members of the Nursing Community Coalition are the cross section of education, practice, research, and regulation within the nursing profession and fully support this legislation which would provide recognition to the nurses who served as members of the United States Cadet Nurse Corps during World War II. The coalition is committed to advancing legislation that supports the nation's nurses and this legislation exceeds that goal by supporting the commitment of those who served during one of the nation's most critical hours.

This year marks the 75th Anniversary of the first class of nurses who served in the United States Cadet Corps starting on July 1, 1943. Over 110,000 nurses honorably served to care for America's service men and women. As the average age of these nurses increases, the time left to act dwindles and the importance of passing this legislation intensifies. The Nursing Community Coalition commends your commitment and efforts to honor our nation's nurses who answered the call to action.
