On behalf of the Nursing Community Coalition, we would like to express our continued commitment to work with you and the Senate HELP Committee to pass the Title VIII Nursing Workforce Reauthorization Act of 2017 (S.1109). This legislation is the keystone of the coalition's advocacy work and remains our number one priority in the 115th Congress. We applaud the committee's efforts to host a hearing next week titled "The Health Care Workforce: Addressing Shortages and Improving Care."

As you know, Title VIII has helped to build the supply and distribution of qualified nurses.
