FOR THE NEW MEMBER WANTING TO BECOME INVOLVED AT THE NATIONAL LEVEL:

- 1 Go to the ANNA Website, www.annanurse.org and click on the button at the far left (at least that's where it is now) entitled "get involved".
- 2 Peruse resources available and see what interests you. There are many avenues – examples include committees of various interests, reviewers for the journal, and legislative initiatives.
- 3 Once you see something that interests you, call the ANNA National office and ask to speak to LouAnn Leary as she will be the best resource to put you in contact with the point person for that committee, project, etc. Other resources at the National office can be found on the website by clicking on "about ANNA" on the face page – top line on the far left. Scroll down on that page and click on National Office Staff. There you will see emails and numbers of those who directly work with the various educational projects, special projects, or the journal.
- 4 Attend the next ANNA National meeting (provided in the spring and fall) and go to the exhibit hall. ANNA has several different booths with members who can get you in contact with those involved in the activities that interest you.
